CAREERS INDUSTRIES' FULFILLMENT SERVICES FORMS PARTNERSHIP WITH
PLEASANT PRAIRIE COMPANY:

Racine WI – Careers Industries announced today that its Fulfillment Services Department has formed a partnership with CPI Plastics Group in Pleasant Prairie, WI to manufacture canliners (trash bags).

Early last year, Careers Industries was awarded a State of Wisconsin Use contract to manufacture trash bags and sell them to the state. Terms of that contract call for 75-percent of the work being performed by people with disabilities.

Under the partnership agreement with CPI, Careers Industries has leased equipment at the company's Pleasant Prairie facility where one of Careers' employees oversees the manufacturing of the bags.

The bags are then transported to a location that Careers leases in Racine where they are packaged for shipment. In 2006, Careers' Fulfillment Services Department manufactured and shipped 13 million canliners.

Careers Industries provides vocational training, employment, learning opportunities, and community-based activities for 240 adults with developmental and/or similar disability. It has facilities at 3502 Douglas Ave. in Racine and 161 Industrial Dr. in Burlington.

In Fulfillment Services, participants do real work for real pay through subcontract light assembly, collating, kitting and packaging for area businesses.

CPI Plastics Group Ltd. is a Canadian-based plastics processor.
