"Always There is a Way" is the message to be presented by Glenn McIntyre with assistance from his service dog, Boylan at the Sunshine House Annual Awards dinner, 6 p.m., Monday, May 7 at Stone Harbor Resort, Sturgeon Bay.

"Our annual dinner is one of the highlights of the year and I am so excited about having Glenn and Boylan as our guest presenters," said Paul Kok, Sunshine House executive director, "This man is nationally recognized as a keynote motivational speaker, trainer and consultant, among other things." McIntyre's presentation is a life-changing message that he lives by. Powerful, inspiring and specifically designed to maximize employees' effectiveness, this keynote address will be customized to target the unique goals of Sunshine House and will be a positive addition to the awards dinner.

As a young police officer, McIntyre's life was forever altered when he was hit by an impaired driver, leaving him a paraplegic. Through eight months of hospitalization and intolerable pain, he had to learn to endure, overcome and then excel at life again. And he did. Not only did McIntyre return to law enforcement for another 14 years, he also became a much sought after professional speaker, an instructor at California State University Northridge and a top 10 nationally ranked wheelchair tennis competitor. Most importantly, he developed the skills for success that he has been sharing with audiences of professionals since 1989.

McIntyre is featured in several *Chicken Soup for the Soul* books, has been on the cover of *Success Magazine*, as a lead article in *Human Resources Executive*, and on every major TV network. Glenn has received numerous commendations as a law enforcement officer and as a citizen of Ventura Co.

Most recently, McIntyre produced and was master of ceremonies of the Annual Festival of Human Abilities, at the Aquarium of the Pacific in Long Beach, CA. More than 10,000 people came to celebrate the abilities of people with disabilities.

Boylan A. Kaynyne is a founding member of McIntyre & Associates. Boylan has dedicated his life to improving lives of people with disabilities. An individual of few words and an excellent listener, Boylan is considered to be one who takes action. Boylan has worked closely with his co-presenter (McIntyre) and together they have received numerous accommodations for their training. Always a hit at speaking events Boylan can raise the "wroof" but is often best remembered for being a good listener. Boylan and McIntyre offer living proof that teamwork is the key to success.

In addition to appearing at the Sunshine House Awards Dinner, McIntyre and Boylan will make several appearances in Door Co. with school groups, Sunshine House employees, families, and volunteers as well as a few other stops along the way.
